COVID-19 UPDATE

We are excited as we have received our second dose of the COVID Vaccine on February 4th. As most know, it takes time for vaccines to build up immunity and the CDC states “typically a few weeks.” We have made it thusfar with none of our residents testing positive and we are super proud of that. We have been truly blessed.

So what is the next step? As we continue to learn all that we can about the virus, we have safety measures put in place so we can start to reopen our facility to visitors. With that being said, we will tentively start to schedule indoor visitations with our indoor chat boxes starting February 18th. At this time, here are the following requirements for indoor visitations.

1. When arriving at the facility we ask that you enter through the east wing doors located at the very end of the east wing closest to the road. You may enter the first set of doors but please wait for a staff member to let you in the second set. Masks must be worn to enter the facility and must remain on for the duration of the visit.
2. Prior to visitation, hand hygiene is required. Visitors will be screened for symptoms. Visitor will be tested at the facility using our rapid tests prior to visitation. If visitor is showing symptoms or the test results is positive, visitor will be asked to exit the building.
3. Only 2 visitors over the age of 18 will be allowed per resident per visit. A limit of 4-6 visitors will be allowed in the building at one time. Resident and vistors will be required to stay in designated visiting areas. We ask that you do not enter another visiting area.
4. Visits will be limited to once a week for 45 min to help ensure that all residents are able to receive visitors.
